1. Capture easy-to-guess passwords from users who use telnet connection, then capture the communications and use dictionary attack.
2. Mis-configure your web server that create a security hole, then launch the attack.
3. Mis-configure your ftp or sendmail and launch attacks.
4. Explore the vulnerabilities in the old packages.
